Dear Member,

The Republic of Ireland Branch Committee will be using fully electronic means of communicating with you from the near future. We are doing this to minimize costs and offer you improved service. The first stage of this process has been completed and we are pleased to introduce the branch website as our main portal for communication:

www.istructe.ie

In the very near future we will be sending emails from the new system. If you currently receive our emails, then you are not required to do anything. If you do not currently receive our emails, you should do two things:

1. Let the Institution in London know your email address by altering your member information (in the member's area) at www.istructe.org. However, this is not required to receive our branch emails.
2. Subscribe to the Republic of Ireland Branch website at www.istructe.ie (top of the left hand menu) with your email address.

There is the possibility that we may have more than one email address for some members. In this case, please use the 'unsubscribe' link, at the bottom of the email (soon to be received) for the accounts to which you do not wish to receive our emails.

Upon occasion in the future we may resort to the traditional mail-shot for some special purposes. However, in general we will no longer send lecture notices, Annual Dinner notices, etc. by traditional means. Event notices will be displayed on the branch website, and emailed at the appropriate time. Further, you will receive a monthly synopsis email on notices posted to the website.
