Nearly Zero Energy Buildings (NZEB's) **- *Planning for 2020***

The European Energy Performance of Buildings Directive requires all new buildings to be Nearly Zero Energy Buildings by 31st December 2020 and all buildings acquired by public bodies to be NZEB's by 31st December 2018. To comply with the NZEB requirement, the Irish Government has issued revised Building Regulations – *Part L – Conservation of Fuel and Energy – Buildings other than Dwellings* for consultation.

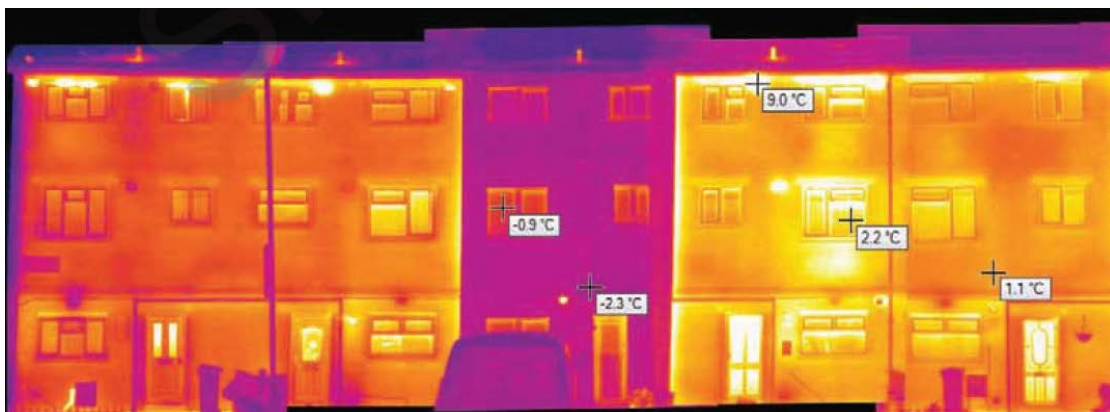
